insurance policies; if the buyer or seller is offered a discounted premium or an economic benefit as an inducement to split the title insurance policies and, at any time before the closing of the transaction, the title insurance company chosen to issue the owner's policy agrees to offer the same discounted premium or economic benefit, the policies shall be issued by the same title insurance company.".
