Short Title. This Act may be cited as the 4 5 Statewide Relocation Towing Licensure Commission Act of 2018. Section 5. The Statewide Relocation Towing Licensure 6 7 Commission. (a) The Statewide Relocation Towing Licensure Commission 8 is created. 10 (b) Within 60 days after the effective date of this Act, the members of the Commission shall be appointed with the 11 12 following members: 13 (1) one member of the General Assembly, appointed by the President of the Senate; 14 15 (2) one member of the General Assembly, appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate; 16

2	the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
3	(4) one member of the General Assembly, appointed by
4	the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives;
5	(5) the Mayor of the City of Chicago, or his or her
6	designee;
7	(6) the Secretary of Transportation, or his or her
8	designee;
9	(7) the Director of State Police, or his or her
10	designee;
11	(8) two members of the public who represent the towing
12	industry, appointed by the President of the Professional
13	Towing and Recovery Operators of Illinois;
14	(9) two members of the public who represent the
15	property casualty insurance industry, appointed by the
16	Executive Director of the Illinois Insurance Association;
17	(10) the President of the Illinois Municipal League, or
18	his or her designee;
19	(11) the President of the Illinois Sheriffs'
20	Association, or his or her designee;
21	(12) the Cook County State's Attorney, or his or her
22	designee;
23	(13) the Chairman of the Illinois Commerce Commission,
24	or his or her designee; and
25	(14) the President of the Northwest Municipal

Conference, or his or her designee.

- compensation for serving as members of the Commission. 2
- Illinois Commerce Commission shall provide 3 (d) The 4 administrative and other support to the Commission.
- 5 Section 10. Meetings.
- (a) Each member of the Commission shall have voting rights 6
- 7 and all actions and recommendations shall be approved by a
- 8 simple majority vote of the members.
- 9 (b) The Commission shall meet no less than 3 times before
- 10 the report described in Section 15 is filed.
- (c) At the initial meeting, the Commission shall elect one 11
- member as a Chairperson, through a simple majority vote, who 12
- 13 shall thereafter call any subsequent meetings.
- 14 Section 15. Reporting.
- (a) No later than December 31, 2019, the Commission shall 15
- 16 submit a report to the Governor and to the General Assembly,
- 17 which shall include, but is not limited to:
- 18 (1) an evaluation of the current towing laws in this
- 19 State:
- 20 (2)recommendation for an appropriate towing
- 21 licensure program for this State;
- 22 (3) a review of all potential litigation costs for an
- 2.3 owner of an impounded vehicle, a towing company, and a
- 24 county or municipality; and

- (4) any other matters the Commission deems necessary. 1
- (b) The report to the General Assembly shall be filed with 2
- 3 the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of
- 4 the Senate in electronic form only, in the manner that the
- 5 Clerk and the Secretary shall direct.
- Section 20. Repealer. This Act is repealed on January 1, 6
- 7 2020.
- 8 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law.". 9
