2 State's Attorney"; and

3 on page 11, line 11, by replacing "petition" with "petition; or
4 ÷"; and

5 on page 11, immediately below line 11, by inserting the
6 following:

7 "(3) by a State's Attorney on behalf of any minor child
8 who is a family or household member of the named victim, if
9 the named victim does not file a petition or request the
10 State's Attorney file the petition."; and

11 on page 11, line 14, by replacing "or" with "~~or~~"; and

12 on page 11, line 15, after "person", by inserting "or by the

14 on page 11, line 18, by replacing "petition" with "petition; or

16 on page 11, immediately below line 18, by inserting the
17 following:

18 "(3) by a State's Attorney on behalf of any minor child
19 who is a family or household member of the named victim, if

1 the named victim does not file a petition or request the
2 State's Attorney file the petition."; and

3 by replacing line 23 on page 11 through line 2 on page 12 with
4 "State's Attorney has a good faith basis to delay filing the
5 petition. The State's Attorney shall inform the person that the
6 State's Attorney will not be filing the petition at that time
7 and that the person may file a petition or may retain an
8 attorney to file the petition. The State's Attorney may file
9 the petition at a later date.".
