- 10 (a) In this Section, "dual credit course" has the meaning
- 11 ascribed to that term in the Dual Credit Quality Act.
- 12 (b) A qualified student shall be allowed to enroll in an
- 13 unlimited amount of dual credit courses and earn an unlimited
- 14 <u>amount of academic credits from dual credit courses if the</u>
- 15 <u>courses are taught by an Illinois instructor, as provided under</u>
- 16 the Dual Credit Quality Act.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> A school board shall require the school district's high
- schools, if any, to inform all 11th and 12th grade students of
- 19 dual enrollment and dual credit opportunities at public
- 20 community colleges for qualified students.
