1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
21B-30 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/21B-30)

7 Sec. 21B-30. Educator testing.

8 (a) This Section applies beginning on July 1, 2012.

9 (b) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the State Educator Preparation and Licensure Board, shall design 10 and implement a system of examinations, which shall be required 11 prior to the issuance of educator licenses. These examinations 12 13 and indicators must be based on national and State professional 14 teaching standards, as determined by the State Board of Education, in consultation with the State Educator Preparation 15 and Licensure Board. The State Board of Education may adopt 16 17 such rules as may be necessary to implement and administer this Section. 18

(c) Applicants seeking a Professional Educator License or an Educator License with Stipulations shall be required to pass a test of basic skills before the license is issued, unless the endorsement the individual is seeking does not require passage of the test. teacher education or school service personnel preparation 1 2 programs shall be required to pass the State Board of Education's recognized test of basic skills prior to starting 3 4 their student teaching or starting the final semester of their 5 internship, unless required earlier at the discretion of the 6 recognized, Illinois institution in which they are completing 7 their approved program. An institution of higher learning, as defined in the Higher Education Student Assistance Act, may not 8 9 require an applicant to complete the State Board's recognized 10 test of basic skills prior to the semester before student 11 teaching or prior to the semester before starting the final 12 semester of an internship. An individual who passes a test of 13 basic skills does not need to do so again for subsequent endorsements or other educator licenses. 14

(d) All applicants seeking a State license shall be required to pass a test of content area knowledge for each area of endorsement for which there is an applicable test. There shall be no exception to this requirement. No candidate shall be allowed to student teach or serve as the teacher of record until he or she has passed the applicable content area test.

(e) (Blank). and completing their student teaching experience no later than August 31, 2015 Prior to September 1, 23 2015, passage The APT shall be available through August 31, 24 2020.

(f) Except as otherwise provided in this Article, beginning
on September 1, 2015, all candidates completing teacher

preparation programs in this State and all candidates subject 1 2 to Section 21B-35 of this Code are required to pass an 3 evidence-based assessment of teacher effectiveness approved by the State Board of Education, in consultation with the State 4 5 Educator Preparation and Licensure Board. All recognized 6 institutions offering approved teacher preparation programs 7 must begin phasing in the approved teacher performance 8 assessment no later than July 1, 2013.

9 (q) Tests of basic skills and content area knowledge and 10 the assessment of professional teaching shall be the tests that 11 from time to time are designated by the State Board of 12 Education, in consultation with the State Educator Preparation 13 and Licensure Board, and may be tests prepared by an 14 educational testing organization or tests designed by the State 15 Board of Education, in consultation with the State Educator 16 Preparation and Licensure Board. The areas to be covered by a 17 test of basic skills shall include reading, language arts, and mathematics. The test of content area knowledge shall assess 18 19 content knowledge in a specific subject field. The tests must 20 be designed to be racially neutral to ensure that no person 21 taking the tests is discriminated against on the basis of race, 22 color, national origin, or other factors unrelated to the 23 person's ability to perform as a licensed employee. The score 24 required to pass the tests shall be fixed by the State Board of 25 Education, in consultation with the State Educator Preparation 26 and Licensure Board. The tests shall be administered not fewer

1 than 3 times a year at such time and place as may be designated 2 by the State Board of Education, in consultation with the State 3 Educator Preparation and Licensure Board.

The State Board shall implement a test or tests to assess the speaking, reading, writing, and grammar skills of applicants for an endorsement or a license issued under subdivision (G) of paragraph (2) of Section 21B-20 of this Code in the English language and in the language of the transitional bilingual education program requested by the applicant.

10 (h) Except as provided in Section 34-6 of this Code, the 11 provisions of this Section shall apply equally in any school 12 district subject to Article 34 of this Code.

13 (i) The rules developed to implement and enforce the 14 testing requirements under this Section shall include without 15 limitation provisions governing test selection, test 16 validation and determination of а passing score, 17 administration of the tests, frequency of administration, applicant fees, frequency of applicants taking the tests, the 18 years for which a score is valid, and appropriate special 19 20 accommodations.
