1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2777

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2777 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Controlled Substances Act is
5 amended by adding Section 315.5 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 570/315.5 new)

7 Sec. 315.5. Opioid education for prescribers. Every
8 prescriber who is licensed to prescribe controlled substances
9 shall, during the pre-renewal period, complete 3 hours of
10 continuing education on safe opioid prescribing practices
11 offered or accredited by a professional association, State
12 government agency, or federal government agency.
13 Notwithstanding any individual licensing Act or administrative
14 rule, a prescriber may count these 3 hours toward the total
15 continuing education hours required for renewal of a
16 professional license. Continuing education on safe opioid

1 prescribing practices applied to meet any other State licensure
2 requirement or professional accreditation or certification
3 requirement may be used toward the requirement under this
4 Section. The Department of Financial and Professional
5 Regulation may adopt rules for the administration of this
6 Section."
