8	(a) The graduation incentive g	grant program is hereby
9	created. The program shall be impleme	ented and administered by
10	the Board of Higher Education to pro	vide grant incentives to
11	public universities that offer thei	r undergraduate students
12	contracts under which the university	commits itself to provide
13	the courses, programs, and support ser	vices necessary to enable
14	the contracting students to graduate	e within 4 years. Grants
15	shall be awarded from appropriation	as made to the Board of
16	Higher Education for purposes of this	Section.

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1 (b) To be eligible for grant consideration, a public university shall annually file a report with the Board of 2 Higher Education detailing its 4-year graduation contract 3 program. The report shall include, at a minimum, the following 4 5 information: the number of undergraduate students participating in the program, the requirements of the 4-year 6 graduation contracts offered by the university, the types of 7 8 additional support services provided by the university to the 9 contracting students, and the cost of the program.

10 (c) In awarding grants to public universities under this 11 Section, the Board of Higher Education may consider each 12 applicant's report data, the number of institutions wishing to 13 participate, and such other criteria as the Board of Higher 14 Education determines to be appropriate.

15 (d) If money is appropriated for grants under this Section 16 for the current fiscal year, the The Board of Higher Education shall annually submit to the Governor and the General Assembly 17 18 a budgetary recommendation for grants under this Section for 19 the upcoming fiscal year and shall notify applicants for grant 20 assistance that the award of grants under this Section for that 21 upcoming fiscal year is contingent upon the availability of 22 appropriated funds.

(e) The Board of Higher Education may adopt such rules as
it deems necessary for administration of the grant program
created by this Section.
