SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

230 ILCS 40/27

Amends the Video Gaming Act. Provides that the Illinois Gaming Board may grant licenses to permit video gaming in a licensed veterans establishment within a municipality or unincorporated area of a county that has prohibited video gaming. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Video Gaming Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 27 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 27. Prohibition of video gaming by political
- 8 subdivision.
- 9 (a) A municipality may pass an ordinance prohibiting video
- 10 gaming within the corporate limits of the municipality. A
- 11 county board may, for the unincorporated area of the county,
- 12 pass an ordinance prohibiting video gaming within the
- unincorporated area of the county.
- 14 (b) The Board, however, may grant licenses to permit video
- 15 gaming in a licensed veterans establishment within a
- 16 municipality or unincorporated area of a county that has
- 17 prohibited video gaming under subsection (a).
