1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3240

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3240 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Amusement Ride and Attraction Safety Act is
5 amended by changing Section 2-2 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 85/2-2) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4052)

7 Sec. 2-2. Definitions. As used in this Act, unless the
8 context otherwise requires:

9 1. "Director" means the Director of Labor or his or her
10 designee.

11 2. "Department" means Department of Labor.

12 3. "Amusement attraction" means an enclosed building or
13 structure, including electrical equipment which is an integral
14 part of the building or structure, through which people walk
15 without the aid of any moving device, that provides amusement,
16 thrills or excitement at a fair, carnival, or an amusement

1 enterprise, except any such enclosed building or structure
2 which is subject to the jurisdiction of a local building code.

3 4. "Amusement ride" means:

4 (a) any mechanized device or combination of devices,
5 including electrical equipment which is an integral part of
6 the device or devices, which carries passengers along,
7 around, or over a fixed or restricted course for the
8 primary purpose of giving its passengers amusement,
9 pleasure, thrills, or excitement;

10 (b) any ski lift, rope tow, or other device used to
11 transport snow skiers;

12 (c) (blank);

13 (d) any dry slide, alpine slide, or toboggan slide;

14 (e) any tram, open car, or combination of open cars or
15 wagons pulled by a tractor or other motorized device which
16 is not licensed by the Secretary of State, which may, but
17 does not necessarily follow a fixed or restricted course,
18 and is used primarily for the purpose of giving its
19 passengers amusement, pleasure, thrills or excitement, and
20 for which an individual fee is charged or a donation
21 accepted with the exception of hayrack rides;

22 (f) any bungee cord or similar elastic device; or

23 (g) any inflatable attraction.

24 5. "Carnival" or "amusement enterprise" means an
25 enterprise which offers amusement or entertainment to the
26 public by means of one or more amusement attractions or

1 amusement rides.

2 6. "Fair" means an enterprise principally devoted to the
3 exhibition of products of agriculture or industry in connection
4 with which amusement rides or amusement attractions are
5 operated.

6 7. "Operator" means a person, or the agent of a person, who
7 owns or controls or has the duty to control the operation of an
8 amusement ride or an amusement attraction at a carnival,
9 amusement enterprise, or fair. "Operator" includes an agency of
10 the State or any of its political subdivisions.

11 8. "Carnival worker" or "amusement enterprise worker"
12 means a person who is employed (and is therefore not a
13 volunteer) by a carnival, amusement enterprise, or fair ~~to~~
14 ~~manage, physically operate, or assist in the operation of an~~
15 ~~amusement ride or amusement attraction when it is open to the~~
16 ~~public.~~

17 9. "Volunteer" means a person who operates or assists in
18 the operation of an amusement ride or amusement attraction for
19 an owner or operator without pay or lodging. An individual
20 shall not be considered a volunteer if the individual is
21 otherwise employed by the same owner or operator to perform the
22 same type of service as those for which the individual proposes
23 to volunteer.

24 10. "Inflatable attraction" means an amusement ride or
25 device designed for use that may include, but not be limited
26 to, bounce, climb, slide, or interactive play, which is made of

1 flexible fabric, is kept inflated by continuous air flow by one
2 or more blowers, and relies upon air pressure to maintain its
3 shape.
