1 SENATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, On May 2, 2018, a WC-130 Hercules cargo plane 2 3 traveling from Savannah, Georgia to Tucson, Arizona crashed 4 shortly after takeoff killing all nine service members on 5 board; and 6 WHEREAS, The nine service members were part of the 156th 7 Airlift Wing, which is home to the "Bucaneros" and had nearly 8 170 years of combined service experience; and 9 WHEREAS, The plane, attached to the Puerto Rico Air 10 National Guard 156th Airlift Wing, was being decommissioned after more than 40 years of use; and 11 12 WHEREAS, As part of Puerto Rico's Air National Guard fleet, 13 the plane could be outfitted for transport, reconnaissance, search and rescue, research, refueling, patrol, or as a 14 15 gunship; and 16 WHEREAS, During the 2017 hurricane season, the Puerto Rico 17 Air National Guard used the aircraft to rescue Americans from the British Virgin Islands after Hurricane Irma; later, it 18 supplied much needed food and water to Puerto Ricans after 19 20 Hurricane Maria; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The roles of the nine airmen who perished were
- 2 essential during each mission in which they participated,
- 3 including the 2017 hurricane recovery rescue and resupply
- 4 efforts; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Major Jose R. Roman Rosado, the pilot, had 18
- 6 years of service; he is survived by his wife and two sons; and
- WHEREAS, Major Carlos Perez Serra, the aircraft navigator,
- 8 had 23 years of service; he is survived by his wife, two sons,
- 9 and a daughter; and
- 10 WHEREAS, First Lieutenant David Albandoz, the co-pilot,
- 11 had 16 years of service; he is survived by his wife and
- 12 daughter; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Senior Master Sergeant Jan Paravisini, an
- 14 aircraft mechanic with 21 years of service, is survived by two
- daughters and a son; and
- WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Jean Audriffred, an airman with 16
- 17 years of service, is survived by his wife and two sons; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Mario Brana, the flight engineer,
- 19 had 17 years of service; he is survived by his mother and
- 20 daughter; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Victor Colon, an airman with 22
- 2 years of service, is survived by his wife and two daughters;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Eric Circuns, a loadmaster with 31
- 5 years of services, is survived by his wife, two stepdaughters,
- 6 and a son; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Senior Airman Roberto Espada had three years of
- 8 service; he is survived by his grandmother; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The crash with nine fatalities brings the total
- 10 number of noncombat-related wrecks of military aircraft to
- 11 seven so far this year, resulting in 27 United States service
- member deaths; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Honoring the courageous men and women who serve in
- 14 uniform is of the highest priority for the Illinois Senate;
- 15 therefore, be it
- 16 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL
- 17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we honor the lives and
- 18 the memory of the nine Puerto Rican service members killed in
- 19 the noncombat-related military plane crash in Savannah,
- 20 Georgia; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That we extend our deepest condolences to the
- families and loved ones of the fallen airmen; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
- 4 presented to the families of the nine Puerto Rican service
- 5 members.
