1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 160

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 160 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Cannabis Control Act is amended by changing
5 Section 5.2 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 550/5.2) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 705.2)

7 Sec. 5.2. Delivery of cannabis on school grounds.

8 (a) Any person who violates subsection (e) of Section 5 in
9 any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any
10 conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport
11 students to or from school or a school related activity, or on
12 any public way within 500 feet of the real property comprising
13 any school, or in any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by
14 a school to transport students to or from school or a school
15 related activity, and at the time of the violation persons
16 under the age of 18 are present, the offense is committed

1 during school hours, or the offense is committed at times when
2 persons under the age of 18 are reasonably expected to be
3 present in the school, in the conveyance, on the real property,
4 or on the public way, such as when after-school activities are
5 occurring, is guilty of a Class 1 felony, the fine for which
6 shall not exceed \$200,000;

7 (b) Any person who violates subsection (d) of Section 5 in
8 any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any
9 conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport
10 students to or from school or a school related activity, or on
11 any public way within 500 feet of the real property comprising
12 any school, or in any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by
13 a school to transport students to or from school or a school
14 related activity, and at the time of the violation persons
15 under the age of 18 are present, the offense is committed
16 during school hours, or the offense is committed at times when
17 persons under the age of 18 are reasonably expected to be
18 present in the school, in the conveyance, on the real property,
19 or on the public way, such as when after-school activities are
20 occurring, is guilty of a Class 2 felony, the fine for which
21 shall not exceed \$100,000;

22 (c) Any person who violates subsection (c) of Section 5 in
23 any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any
24 conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport
25 students to or from school or a school related activity, or on
26 any public way within 500 feet of the real property comprising

1 any school, or in any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by
2 a school to transport students to or from school or a school
3 related activity, and at the time of the violation persons
4 under the age of 18 are present, the offense is committed
5 during school hours, or the offense is committed at times when
6 persons under the age of 18 are reasonably expected to be
7 present in the school, in the conveyance, on the real property,
8 or on the public way, such as when after-school activities are
9 occurring, is guilty of a Class 3 felony, the fine for which
10 shall not exceed \$50,000;

11 (d) Any person who violates subsection (b) of Section 5 in
12 any school, on the real property comprising any school, or any
13 conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to transport
14 students to or from school or a school related activity, or on
15 any public way within 500 feet of the real property comprising
16 any school, or in any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by
17 a school to transport students to or from school or a school
18 related activity, and at the time of the violation persons
19 under the age of 18 are present, the offense is committed
20 during school hours, or the offense is committed at times when
21 persons under the age of 18 are reasonably expected to be
22 present in the school, in the conveyance, on the real property,
23 or on the public way, such as when after-school activities are
24 occurring, is guilty of a Class 4 felony, the fine for which
25 shall not exceed \$25,000;

26 (e) Any person who violates subsection (a) of Section 5 in

1 any school, on the real property comprising any school, or in
2 any conveyance owned, leased or contracted by a school to
3 transport students to or from school or a school related
4 activity, on any public way within 500 feet of the real
5 property comprising any school, or any conveyance owned, leased
6 or contracted by a school to transport students to or from
7 school or a school related activity, and at the time of the
8 violation persons under the age of 18 are present, the offense
9 is committed during school hours, or the offense is committed
10 at times when persons under the age of 18 are reasonably
11 expected to be present in the school, in the conveyance, on the
12 real property, or on the public way, such as when after-school
13 activities are occurring, is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

14 (f) This Section does not apply to a violation that occurs
15 in or on the grounds of a building that is designated as a
16 school but is no longer operational or active as a school,
17 including a building that is temporarily or permanently closed
18 by a unit of local government.
