SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.69 new
105 ILCS 5/34-18.61 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a school board may immediately suspend or terminate the employment of any person employed by a school district or contracted to work for a school district who has been convicted of a sex offense; defines "sex offense". Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5 10-20.69 and 34-18.61 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.69 new)

7 Sec. 10-20.69. Employee suspension or termination; sex
8 offense. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
9 contrary, a school board may immediately suspend or terminate
10 the employment of any person employed by a school district or
11 contracted to work for a school district who has been convicted
12 of a sex offense, as defined under Section 2 of the Sex
13 Offender Registration Act.

15 Sec. 34-18.61. Employee suspension or termination; sex
16 offense. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
17 contrary, the board may immediately suspend or terminate the
18 employment of any person employed by the school district or
19 contracted to work for the school district who has been
20 convicted of a sex offense, as defined under Section 2 of the
21 Sex Offender Registration Act.

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
2 becoming law.
