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1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 543
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 543 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act is amended
5	by changing Section 15-70 as follows:
6	(410 ILCS 705/15-70)
7	Sec. 15-70. Operational requirements; prohibitions.
8	(a) A dispensing organization shall operate in accordance
9	with the representations made in its application and license
10	materials. It shall be in compliance with this Act and rules.
11	(b) A dispensing organization must include the legal name
12	of the dispensary on the packaging of any cannabis product it
13	sells.
14	(c) All cannabis, cannabis-infused products, and cannabis
15	seeds must be obtained from an Illinois registered adult use
16	cultivation center, craft grower, infuser, or another

1 dispensary.

2 (d) Dispensing organizations are prohibited from selling 3 any product containing alcohol except tinctures, which must be 4 limited to containers that are no larger than 100 milliliters.

5 (e) A dispensing organization shall inspect and count 6 product received from a transporting organization, adult use 7 cultivation center, craft grower, infuser organization, or 8 other dispensing organization before dispensing it.

9 (f) A dispensing organization may only accept cannabis 10 deliveries into a restricted access area. Deliveries may not be 11 accepted through the public or limited access areas unless 12 otherwise approved by the Department.

13 (g) A dispensing organization shall maintain compliance 14 with State and local building, fire, and zoning requirements or 15 regulations.

16 (h) A dispensing organization shall submit a list to the Department of the names of all service professionals that will 17 18 work at the dispensary. The list shall include a description of the type of business or service provided. Changes to the 19 20 service professional list shall be promptly provided. No service professional shall work in the dispensary until the 21 22 name is provided to the Department on the service professional list. 23

24 (i) A dispensing organization's license allows for a25 dispensary to be operated only at a single location.

26 (j) A dispensary may operate between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m.

1 local time.

2 (k) A dispensing organization must keep all lighting
3 outside and inside the dispensary in good working order and
4 wattage sufficient for security cameras.

5 (1) A dispensing organization must keep all air treatment 6 systems that will be installed to reduce odors in good working 7 order.

8 (m) A dispensing organization must contract with a private 9 security contractor that is licensed under Section 10-5 of the 10 Private Detective, Private Alarm, Private Security, 11 Fingerprint Vendor, and Locksmith Act of 2004 to provide 12 on-site security at all hours of the dispensary's operation.

(n) A dispensing organization shall ensure that any building or equipment used by a dispensing organization for the storage or sale of cannabis is maintained in a clean and sanitary condition.

17 (o) The dispensary shall be free from infestation by18 insects, rodents, or pests.

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(p) A dispensing organization shall not:

(1) Produce or manufacture cannabis;

(2) Accept a cannabis product from an adult use
cultivation center, craft grower, infuser, dispensing
organization, or transporting organization unless it is
pre-packaged and labeled in accordance with this Act and
any rules that may be adopted pursuant to this Act;

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(3) Obtain cannabis or cannabis-infused products from

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## outside the State of Illinois;

(4) Sell cannabis or cannabis-infused products to a 2 3 purchaser unless the dispensing organization is licensed under the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Program 4 5 individual is registered under Act, and the the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Program or the 6 7 purchaser has been verified to be 21 years of age or older;

8 (5) Enter into an exclusive agreement with any adult 9 use cultivation center, craft grower, or infuser. 10 Dispensaries shall provide consumers an assortment of 11 products from various cannabis business establishment 12 licensees such that the inventory available for sale at any 13 dispensary from any single cultivation center, craft 14 grower, processor, transporter, or infuser entity shall 15 not be more than 40% of the total inventory available for sale. For the purpose of this subsection, a cultivation 16 center, craft grower, processor, or infuser shall be 17 18 considered part of the same entity if the licensees share 19 at least one principal officer. The Department may request 20 that a dispensary diversify its products as needed or 21 otherwise discipline a dispensing organization for 22 violating this requirement;

(6) Refuse to conduct business with an adult use
 cultivation center, craft grower, transporting
 organization, or infuser that has the ability to properly
 deliver the product and is permitted by the Department of

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1 the same terms as other adult Agriculture, on 11.SP 2 cultivation centers, craft growers, infusers, or 3 transporters with whom it is dealing; 4 (7) Operate drive-through windows; 5 Allow for the dispensing of (8) cannabis or cannabis-infused products in vending machines; 6 Transport cannabis to residences 7 (9) or other 8 locations where purchasers may be for delivery; 9 (10) Enter into agreements to allow persons who are not 10 dispensing organization agents to deliver cannabis or to 11 transport cannabis to purchasers; (11) Operate a dispensary if its video surveillance 12 13 equipment is inoperative; 14 (12)Operate a dispensary if the point-of-sale 15 equipment is inoperative; 16 (13) Operate a dispensary if the State's cannabis 17 electronic verification system is inoperative; 18 (14) Have fewer than 2 people working at the dispensary 19 at any time while the dispensary is open; 20 (15) Be located within 1,500 feet of the property line 21 of a pre-existing dispensing organization; 22 (16) Sell clones or any other live plant material; 23 cannabis, cannabis concentrate, (17)Sell or 24 cannabis-infused products in combination or bundled with 25 each other or any other items for one price, and each item 26 of cannabis, concentrate, or cannabis-infused product must

be separately identified by quantity and price on the receipt;

3 (18) Violate any other requirements or prohibitions4 set by Department rules.

5 (g) It is unlawful for any person having an Early Approval 6 Adult Use Cannabis Dispensing Organization License, а Conditional Adult Use Cannabis Dispensing Organization, an 7 Adult Use Dispensing Organization License, or a medical 8 9 cannabis dispensing organization license issued under the 10 Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Program Act or any 11 officer, associate, member, representative, or agent of such licensee to accept, receive, or borrow money or anything else 12 13 of value or accept or receive credit (other than merchandising 14 credit in the ordinary course of business for a period not to 15 exceed 30 days) directly or indirectly from any adult use 16 cultivation center, craft grower, infuser, or transporting organization in exchange for preferential placement on the 17 dispensing organization's shelves, display cases, or website. 18 This includes anything received or borrowed or from any 19 20 stockholders, officers, agents, or persons connected with an 21 adult use cultivation center, craft grower, infuser, or 22 transporting organization.

(r) It is unlawful for any person having an Early Approval
 Adult Use Cannabis Dispensing Organization License, a
 Conditional Adult Use Cannabis Dispensing Organization, an
 Adult Use Dispensing Organization License, or a medical

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1	cannabis dispensing organization license issued under the
2	Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Program to enter into any
3	contract with any person licensed to cultivate, process, or
4	transport cannabis whereby such dispensing organization agrees
5	not to sell any cannabis cultivated, processed, transported,
6	manufactured, or distributed by any other cultivator,
7	transporter, or infuser, and any provision in any contract
8	violative of this Section shall render the whole of such
9	contract void and no action shall be brought thereon in any
10	court.
11	(s) A dispensing organization must be located at least 500
12	feet from a facility that provides treatment for substance
13	abuse.
