Amend House Bill 895, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 4 2, on page 1, line 5, by deleting "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing"; and 5 by deleting line 6 on page 1 through line 9 on page 2; and 6 7 on page 109, line 23, by replacing "Crohn's disease" with "Crohn's disease (including, but not limited to, ulcerative 8 colitis),"; and 10 on page 130, by replacing lines 2 through 8 with the following: 11 "(1) accept, solicit, or offer any form of remuneration from or to a qualifying patient, primary caregiver, 12 cultivation center, or dispensing organization, including 13 14 each principal officer, board member, agent, and employee,

to certify a patient, other than accepting payment from a

- 1 patient for the fee associated with the required
- examination, except for the limited purpose of performing a 2
- medical cannabis-related research study;"; and 3
- 4 on page 130, immediately below line 8, by inserting the
- 5 following:
- "(1.5) accept, solicit, or offer any form of 6
- remuneration from or to a medical cannabis cultivation 7
- 8 center or dispensary organization for the purposes of
- 9 referring a patient to a specific dispensary
- 10 organization;"; and
- 11 on page 130, line 9, by replacing "(1.5)" with "(1.10)"; and
- 12 on page 132, line 12, by replacing "including certification"
- with "except when the referral is limited to certification 13
- purposes only"; and 14
- on page 149, line 9, by replacing "18" with " $21 \over 18$ "; and 15
- on page 149, line 11, after "cannabis", by inserting "or 16
- paraphernalia used for smoking or vaping medical cannabis"; and 17
- 18 on page 169, immediately below line 24, by inserting the
- 19 following:
- "(g) The Department of Financial and Professional 20

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Regulation may issue nondisciplinary citations for minor violations which may be accompanied by a civil penalty not to exceed \$10,000 per violation. The penalty shall be a civil penalty or other condition as established by rule. The citation shall be issued to the licensee and shall contain the licensee's name, address, and license number, a brief factual statement, the Sections of the law or rule allegedly violated, and the civil penalty, if any, imposed. The citation must clearly state that the licensee may choose, in lieu of accepting the citation, to request a hearing. If the licensee does not dispute the matter in the citation with the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation within 30 days after the citation is served, then the citation shall become final and shall not be subject to appeal.".
