1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1673 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1673 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing 4 Section 19A-15 as follows: 5 6 (10 ILCS 5/19A-15) 7 Sec. 19A-15. Period for early voting; hours. (a) The period for early voting by personal appearance 8 begins the 40th day preceding a general primary, consolidated 10 primary, consolidated, or general election and extends through the end of the day before election day. 11 12 (b) Except as otherwise provided by this Section, a permanent polling place for early voting must remain open 13

beginning the 15th day before an election through the end of

the day before election day during the hours of 8:30 a.m. to

4:30 p.m., or 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on weekdays, except that

- 1 beginning 8 days before election day, a permanent polling place
- for early voting must remain open during the hours of 8:30 a.m.
- 3 to 7:00 p.m., or 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and 9:00 a.m. to 12:00
- 4 p.m. on Saturdays and holidays, and 10:00 a.m. to 4 p.m. on
- 5 Sundays; except that, in addition to the hours required by this
- 6 subsection, a permanent polling place designated by an election
- 7 authority under subsections (c), (d), and (e) of Section 19A-10
- 8 must remain open for a total of at least 8 hours on any holiday
- 9 during the early voting period and a total of at least 14 hours
- on the final weekend during the early voting period.
- 11 Notwithstanding the requirements of this subsection (b),
- 12 the day before a general primary, consolidated primary, or a
- general or consolidated election, a county clerk's office may
- 14 close at 6:00 p.m.
- 15 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (b), an election authority
- 16 may close an early voting polling place if the building in
- 17 which the polling place is located has been closed by the State
- or unit of local government in response to a severe weather
- 19 emergency or other force majeure. The election authority shall
- 20 notify the State Board of Elections of any closure and shall
- 21 make reasonable efforts to provide notice to the public of an
- 22 alternative location for early voting.
