## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding 4 5 Section 11-1432 as follows:
- (625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new) 6
- 7 Sec. 11-1432. Prohibit smoking in a motor vehicle with a
- 8 minor present.
- 9 (a) For purposes of this Section:
- "Smoke" means to inhale, exhale, burn, or carry a lighted 10 cigarette, cigar, pipe, weed, plant, regulated narcotic, or
- 12 other combustible substance.
- "Vehicle" has the same meaning as defined in Section 1-217 13
- 14 of this Code and does not include motorcycles as defined in
- 15 Section 1-147.
- 16 (b) A person shall not smoke in a motor vehicle, whether it
- is in motion or at rest, if a person under 18 years of age is in 17
- the vehicle, regardless of whether the vehicle's windows are 18
- 19 open.

- (c) A police officer may not stop or detain a motor vehicle 20
- 21 or its driver nor inspect or search the vehicle, the contents
- 22 of the vehicle, or the operator or passenger of the vehicle
- solely for a violation or suspected violation of this Section. 2.3

- (d) A violation of this Section is a petty offense 1
- 2 punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100 and, for a second or
- subsequent offense, a fine not to exceed \$250. 3
