8	Sec. 3. The corporate authority of	of the Sanitary District of
9	Chicago shall consist of nine trustee	es. Such trustees shall be
10	elected for staggered terms at the	election provided by the
11	general election law. <u>Except as prov</u>	ided by Section 3.3, three
12	Three trustees shall be elected a	at each such election to
13	succeed the 3 trustees whose terms ex	pire in such year.
14	Such trustees shall take office	on the first Tuesday after
15	the first Monday in the month foll	lowing the month of their
16	election and shall hold their office	es for six years and until

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1 their successors shall be elected and qualified. Except for elections of the commissioners of the Metropolitan Water 2 Reclamation District of Greater Chicago on and after the 2022 3 4 general election, in In all elections for trustees each elector 5 may vote for as many candidates as there are trustees to be 6 elected, but no elector may give to such candidates more than one vote, it being the intent and purpose of this Act to 7 8 prohibit cumulative voting in the selection of members of the 9 board of the sanitary district.

10 The election of trustees shall be in accordance with the 11 provisions of the general election law.

By reason of the importance and character of the services performed by the sanitary district, there is a great need and it is in the public interest that such services be performed in as near a non-partisan character as possible.

16 When a vacancy exists in the office of trustees of any 17 sanitary district organized under the provisions hereof, the 18 vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the Governor until 19 the next regular election at which trustees of the Sanitary 20 District of Chicago are elected, and thereafter until a 21 successor shall be elected and qualified.

Such sanitary district shall from the time of the first election held by it under this Act be construed in all courts to be a body corporate and politic, and by the name and style of the sanitary district of..., and by such name and style may sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, acquire and 10100HB2624ham001 -3- LRB101 08645 AWJ 57671 a

hold real estate and personal property necessary for corporate purposes, and adopt a common seal and alter the same at pleasure.

4 The board of trustees shall have the power to change the 5 name of the Sanitary District of Chicago by ordinance and public notice without impairing the legal status of acts 6 theretofore performed by said district. Thereafter any and all 7 references to the Sanitary District of Chicago in this Act or 8 9 otherwise shall mean and include the name under which such 10 sanitary district is then operating. No rights, duties or 11 privilege of such a sanitary district, or those of any person, existing before the change of name shall be affected by a 12 13 change, in the name of a sanitary district. All proceedings pending in any court in favor of or against such sanitary 14 15 district may continue to final consummation under the name in 16 which they were commenced.

19 <u>Sec. 3.3. Districting required; election.</u>

20 (a) The General Assembly shall: on or before July 1, 2021, 21 divide the Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago into 9 22 commissioner districts and assign the commissioner districts 23 to reflect the results of the most recent federal decennial 24 census; and thereafter, in the year following each decennial 25 census, redistrict the commissioner districts to reflect the 10100HB2624ham001

1	results of the most recent census. Each commissioner district	
2	shall be compact, contiguous, and substantially equal in	
3	population to each other district. At the meeting of the board	
4	of commissioners next following the districting by the General	
5	Assembly, the board of commissioners shall, publicly by lot,	
6	divide the commissioner districts into 3 groups. In the 2022	
7	general election, the commissioners from the first group shall	
8	be elected for a term of 2 years, the commissioners from the	
9	second group shall be elected for a term of 4 years, and the	
10	commissioners from the third group shall be elected for a term	
11	of 6 years. Thereafter, all the terms shall be 6 years and	
12	elected pursuant to Section 3 of this Act. One commissioner	
13	shall be elected from each commissioner district and the	
14	commissioner shall be a resident of the commissioner district	
15	from which he or she is elected.	
16	(b) If the corporate limits of the District expand between	
17	redistrictings, the board of commissioners shall determine	
18	which commissioner district or districts the expanded	
19	territory will join until the next redistricting.	
20	(c) The terms of all commissioners serving at the time of	
21	the 2022 general election shall continue until the first	
22	Tuesday after the first Monday in the month following the 2022	
23	general election or until the 9 new commissioners are elected	
24	and qualified under subsection (a), whichever is later.".
