## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Energy Efficient Building Act is amended by

- 8 "Board" means the Capital Development Board.
- 9 "Building" includes both residential buildings and

- "Code" means the latest published edition of the

- 13 Code as adopted by the Board, <del>excluding published supplements</del>
- 14 but including any published supplements adopted by the Board
- $\underline{\text{and any}}$  the amendments and adaptations to the Code that are
- made by the Board.
- "Commercial building" means any building except a building
- 18 that is a residential building, as defined in this Section.
- "Department" means the Department of Commerce and Economic
- 20 Opportunity.
- "Municipality" means any city, village, or incorporated
- 22 town.
- "Residential building" means (i) a detached one-family or

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- 2-family dwelling or (ii) any building that is 3 stories or 1 2 less in height above grade that contains multiple dwelling 3 units, in which the occupants reside on a primarily permanent 4 basis, such as a townhouse, a row house, an apartment house, a 5 convent, a monastery, a rectory, a fraternity or sorority 6 house, a dormitory, and a rooming house; provided, however, that when applied to a building located within the boundaries 7 of a municipality having a population of 1,000,000 or more, the 8 term "residential building" means a building containing one or 9 10 more dwelling units, not exceeding 4 stories above grade, where 11 occupants are primarily permanent.
