

1 AN ACT concerning homeless shelters.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the  
5 Feminine Hygiene Products For The Homeless Act.

6 Section 5. Access to feminine hygiene products. Feminine  
7 hygiene products, including, but not limited to, sanitary  
8 napkins, tampons, and panty liners, shall be available free of  
9 charge at all homeless shelters that provide temporary housing  
10 assistance to women or youth. As used in this Act, "homeless  
11 shelter" means a supervised publicly or privately operated  
12 shelter designed to provide temporary living accommodations to  
13 individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate residence.
