### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-805

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-805

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the registration period and fee for electric vehicles shall be the same as the registration period and fee for non-electric motor vehicles. Deletes language limiting the registration fee for electric vehicles to \$18 per registration year.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing  
5 Section 3-805 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-805) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-805)

7 Sec. 3-805. Electric vehicles. The owner of a motor  
8 vehicle of the first division or a motor vehicle of the second  
9 division weighing 8,000 pounds or less propelled by an electric  
10 engine and not utilizing motor fuel, may register such vehicle  
11 for the registration period and fee for non-electric motor  
12 vehicles under Section 3-806 ~~a fee not to exceed \$35 for a~~  
13 ~~2-year registration period.~~ The Secretary may, in his  
14 discretion, prescribe that electric vehicle registration  
15 plates be issued for an indefinite term, such term to  
16 correspond to the term of registration plates issued generally,  
17 as provided in Section 3-414.1. ~~In no event may the~~  
18 ~~registration fee for electric vehicles exceed \$18 per~~  
19 ~~registration year.~~
