SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3930/9.4 new 30 ILCS 105/5.891 new

Amends the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Act. Creates the Statewide Deferred Prosecution Funding Program, to provide grants to State's Attorneys to operate deferred prosecution programs for misdemeanor offenses. Provides eligibility requirements and rulemaking authority for the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority Act. Creates the Statewide Deferred Prosecution Funding Program Fund. Amends the State Finance Act to make a conforming change.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Criminal Justice Information Act is
 amended by adding Section 9.4 as follows:

7 Sec. 9.4. Statewide Deferred Prosecution Funding Program. The Statewide Deferred Prosecution Funding Program Fund is 8 9 hereby created as a special fund in the State treasury. Grants from the Fund shall be made, subject to appropriation, by the 10 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority to State's 11 12 Attorneys upon application in the amount of 25% of the costs 13 incurred by the county to operate the deferred prosecution 14 program. To be eligible to receive moneys from the Fund, a State's Attorney must provide a deferred prosecution program 15 16 that allows for a misdemeanor charge to be dismissed upon successful completion of the deferred prosecution program 17 created by the State's Attorney. The Authority shall by rule 18 19 provide selection criteria and procedures for grants to be made 20 under this Section.
