SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/7-135.5 new
30 ILCS 805/8.43 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Provides that a participating municipality or instrumentality shall post on its publicly available website, if the participating municipality or instrumentality maintains a publicly available website: (1) all documents pertaining to the municipality's or instrumentality's adoption of a resolution to participate in the Fund if the municipality or instrumentality has adopted such a resolution; (2) all documents pertaining to the municipality's or instrumentality's annual projected future contributions to the Fund; and (3) information about the amount of the municipality's or instrumentality's past required contributions to the Fund for each year of participation. Provides that the public posting requirement does not require a participating municipality or instrumentality to post on its website information that is not subject to disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement by the State. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding
5 Section 7-135.5 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/7-135.5 new)

7 Sec. 7-135.5. Required public posting of information by
8 participating municipalities and instrumentalities. A
9 participating municipality or instrumentality shall post on
10 its publicly available website, if the participating
11 municipality or instrumentality maintains a publicly available
12 website: (1) all documents pertaining to the municipality's or
13 instrumentality's adoption of a resolution to participate
14 under this Article if the municipality or instrumentality has
15 adopted such a resolution; (2) all documents pertaining to the
16 municipality's or instrumentality's annual projected future
17 contributions under this Article; and (3) information about the
18 amount of the municipality's or instrumentality's past
19 required contributions to the Fund for each year of
20 participation. This Section does not require a participating
21 municipality or instrumentality to post on its website
22 information that is exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of
23 Information Act.

1 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
2 Section 8.43 as follows:

3 (30 ILCS 805/8.43 new)

4 Sec. 8.43. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
5 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
6 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
7 the 101st General Assembly.

8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
9 becoming law.
