Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Open Meetings Act is amended by adding Section 7.4 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 7.4. Required public posting of information by participating municipalities and instrumentalities under the 8 9 Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund. A participating 10 municipality or instrumentality under Article 7 of the Illinois Pension Code shall post on its publicly available website, if 11 12 the participating municipality or instrumentality maintains a publicly available website: (1) all documents pertaining to the 13 14 municipality's or instrumentality's adoption of a resolution to participate under Article 7 of the Illinois Pension Code if 15 16 the municipality or instrumentality has adopted such a resolution; (2) all documents pertaining to the municipality's 17 or instrumentality's annual projected future contributions 18 19 under Article 7 of the Illinois Pension Code; and (3) information about the amount of the municipality's or 20 21 instrumentality's past required contributions to the Illinois 22 Municipal Retirement Fund for each year of participation. This Section does not require a participating municipality or 2.3

- exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act. 2

- 6 Sec. 8.43. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
