1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3263

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3263 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause as follows:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding  
5 Section 7-135.5 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/7-135.5 new)

7 Sec. 7-135.5. Required public posting of information by the  
8 Fund.

9 (a) The Fund shall post on its publicly available website  
10 the following information regarding municipalities that  
11 participate in the Fund that the Fund has in its possession:  
12 (1) copies of all resolutions adopted by a municipality on or  
13 after January 1, 1995 to participate in the Fund if such a  
14 resolution was required; (2) an annual report listing each  
15 municipality and the date each municipality first became a  
16 municipality that participates in the Fund; (3) all documents

1 pertaining to each municipality's annual projected future  
2 contributions under this Article; and (4) information about the  
3 amount of each municipality's past required contributions to  
4 the Fund for each year of participation on or after January 1,  
5 1995 and before, if available.

6 (b) A municipality that has a website that is maintained by  
7 the full-time staff of the municipality shall post to its  
8 website, no later than January 1, 2021, a link to the  
9 information provided by the Fund under this Section. A  
10 municipality that establishes a website that is maintained by  
11 the full-time staff of the municipality on or after January 1,  
12 2021 shall post to its website a link to the information  
13 provided by the Fund under this Section.

14 (c) This Section does not require the Fund to post on its  
15 website information that is exempt from disclosure under the  
16 Freedom of Information Act.

17 This Section does not require a municipality to establish  
18 or maintain a website.

19 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding  
20 Section 8.43 as follows:

21 (30 ILCS 805/8.43 new)

22 Sec. 8.43. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8  
23 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the  
24 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of

1 the 101st General Assembly.

2           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
3 2020.".
