Amend House Bill 3263 by replacing everything after the enacting clause as follows: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding 4 Section 7-135.5 as follows: 5 (40 ILCS 5/7-135.5 new)6 7 Sec. 7-135.5. Required public posting of information by the 8 Fund. (a) The Fund shall post on its publicly available website the following information regarding municipalities that 10 participate in the Fund that the Fund has in its possession: 11 (1) copies of all resolutions adopted by a municipality on or 12 after January 1, 1995 to participate in the Fund if such a 13 resolution was required; (2) an annual report listing each 14 15 municipality and the date each municipality first became a 16 municipality that participates in the Fund; (3) all documents

- contributions under this Article; and (4) information about the 2
- amount of each municipality's past required contributions to 3
- 4 the Fund for each year of participation on or after January 1,
- 5 1995 and before, if available.
- 6 (b) A municipality that has a website that is maintained by
- the full-time staff of the municipality shall post to its 7
- website, no later than January 1, 2021, a link to the 8
- 9 information provided by the Fund under this Section. A
- 10 municipality that establishes a website that is maintained by
- 11 the full-time staff of the municipality on or after January 1,
- 2021 shall post to its website a link to the information 12
- 13 provided by the Fund under this Section.
- 14 (c) This Section does not require the Fund to post on its
- website information that is exempt from disclosure under the 15
- 16 Freedom of Information Act.
- This Section does not require a municipality to establish 17
- 18 or maintain a website.
- 19 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
- Section 8.43 as follows: 2.0
- 21 (30 ILCS 805/8.43 new)
- 22 Sec. 8.43. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- 23 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- 24 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
