

## 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 HB3541

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

775 ILCS 5/6-103 new

Amends the Illinois Human Rights Act. Provides that it is a civil rights violation for a vendor to decide on the basis of unlawful discrimination which candidates are required to take a test required for application or consideration of the government job. Provides that if a vendor violates the Act, then the vendor is subject to a \$1,000,000 civil penalty for each violation. Provides that any government contract with a vendor that violates the Act shall be terminated. Provides that a government entity shall not contract with a vendor for one year after a determination that the vendor has violated the new provisions. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Human Rights Act is amended by adding Section 6-103 as follows:
- 6 (775 ILCS 5/6-103 new)
- 7 Sec. 6-103. Government job candidates. It is a civil rights violation for a vendor to decide on the basis of unlawful 8 9 discrimination which candidates are required to take a test 10 required for application or consideration of the government job. If a vendor violates this Section, then the vendor is 11 subject to a \$1,000,000 civil penalty for each violation, 12 payable to the State. Any government contract with a vendor 13 14 that violates this Section shall be terminated. A government entity shall not contract with a vendor for one year after a 15 16 determination that the vendor has violated this Section.
- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 18 becoming law.
