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AN ACT concerning property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. (a) The Director of the Department of Natural 5 Resources, on behalf of the State of Illinois, is authorized to 6 execute and deliver to Rend Lake Conservancy District, a unit 7 of local government organized and existing under the laws of 8 this State, of Franklin County, for and in consideration of \$1 9 paid to the Department, a quitclaim deed to the following 10 described real property:

Part of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northwest 11 Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Nineteen (19), Township Five 12 South, Range Three (3) East of the Third (3rd) 13 (5) 14 Principal Meridian, more particularly described as 15 follows: Beginning at a bureau of land management metal marker designated as AP 42 at the Northwest corner of the 16 17 Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 19; thence North 89°-46'-51" E along the North line 18 of said Section 19 to an iron pin on the Westerly 19 20 Right-of-Way of F. A. Route 126; a distance of 350.38 Feet; thence along a non-tangent curve concave to the East having 21 22 a radius of 1131.74 Feet and to which beginning a radial line bears N 84°-37'-57" W; thence Southeasterly 266.74 23 Feet along said curve through a central angle of 24

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13°-30'-14"; thence N 81°-50'-15" ${\tt E}$ to an iron pin on said 1 2 Right-of-Way, a distance of 15.00 Feet; thence along a 3 non-tangent curve concave to the East having a radius of 1116.74 Feet and to which beginning a radial line bears S 4 5 81°-51'-51" W; thence Southeasterly 413.72 along said curve through a central angle of 21°-13'-36"; thence S 6 7 89°-46'-51" W to an iron pin on the West line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 8 19, a distance of 502.58 Feet; thence N 0°-06'-47" W along 9 10 said West line a distance of 654.02 Feet to the point of beginning, excepting all the coal, oil, gas and other 11 12 minerals underlying the same and all rights and easements in favor of the owner of the mineral estate or of any party 13 claiming by, through or under said estate, situated in 14 FRANKLIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS. 15

(b) The conveyance of real property authorized by this
Section shall be made subject to: (1) existing public
utilities, existing public roads, and any and all reservations,
easements, encumbrances, covenants and restrictions of record;
and (2) the express condition that if the real property ceases
to be used for public purposes, it shall revert to the State of
Illinois, Department of Natural Resources.
