### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.73 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.66 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that within 7 days after receiving information that a public school employee is charged with a sex offense, the school board shall notify, in writing, the parents or guardians of the school's students. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
10-20.73 and 34-18.66 as follows:

Sec. 10-20.73. Notice of sex offense charge against an employee. Within 7 days after receiving information that a school employee is charged with a sex offense, as defined under the Sex Offender Registration Act, the school board shall notify, in writing, the parents or guardians of the school's students.
