## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

60 ILCS 1/235-25

Amends the Township Code. Provides that tentative budgets for specified road districts shall be subject to a public hearing and public inspection prior to adopting. Further provides that the township board may adopt all or part of the tentative budget and appropriation ordinance for road purposes and levy the amount determined by the board (currently, the township board shall adopt all the tentative budget and appropriation ordinance and levy the amount determined by the highway commissioner). Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing Section
235-25 as follows:

6 (60 ILCS 1/235-25)

Sec. 235-25. Tentative budget and appropriation ordinance and tax for road purposes. In each road district comprised of a single township:

10 <u>(a) The township board must hold a public hearing before</u> 11 <u>adopting a budget and appropriation ordinance for road</u> 12 purposes.

(b) The township board must, at least 30 days before a 13 14 public hearing, prepare or cause to be prepared a tentative budget and appropriation ordinance for road purposes and file 15 16 the ordinance with the township clerk. The township clerk must 17 make the tentative budget and appropriation ordinance for road purposes available for public inspection for at least 30 days 18 19 before final action on the ordinance. The required public hearing must be held on or before the last day of the first 20 21 quarter of the fiscal year before the township board. Notice of 22 the hearing must be given by publication in a newspaper published in the township at least 30 days before the time of 23

the hearing. If there is no newspaper published in the township, notice of the public hearing may be given by posting notices in 5 of the most public places in the township. It is the duty of the township clerk to arrange for the public hearing.

6 <u>(c) The</u>, the township board <u>may</u> shall adopt <u>all or part of</u> 7 a tentative budget and appropriation ordinance for road 8 purposes, as the township board deems necessary, and shall levy 9 the amount determined by the <u>board</u> highway commissioner and 10 certify to the county clerk the amount necessary to be raised 11 by taxation for road purposes as provided in Section 6-501 of 12 the Illinois Highway Code.
