

101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 HB4927

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 5/232 new

Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Provides that the owner of a pollinator-friendly solar site is entitled to an income tax credit in the amount of \$250 per taxable year.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by adding Section 232 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 5/232 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 232. Pollinator-friendly solar site credit.</u>
- 8 (a) For taxable years ending on or after December 31, 2020,
- 9 the owner of a pollinator-friendly solar site designated under
- 10 <u>the Pollinator-Friendly Solar Site Act is entitled to a credit</u>
- against the tax imposed by subsections (a) and (b) of Section
- 12 201 in the amount of \$250 per taxable year.
- 13 (b) The credit or credits may not reduce the taxpayer's
- liability to less than zero. If the amount of the credit or
- credits exceeds the taxpayer's liability, the excess may be
- 16 carried forward and applied against the taxpayer's liability
- 17 for the next 5 succeeding calendar years. The credit or credits
- shall be applied to the earliest year for which there is a tax
- 19 liability. If there are credits from more than one taxable year
- 20 that are available to offset a liability, the earlier credit
- 21 shall be applied first.
- 22 (c) This Section is exempt from the provisions of Section
- 23 <u>250.</u>
