SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.73 new
105 ILCS 5/34-18.66 new

Amends the School Code. Requires school districts to provide contact information for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline and for the Crisis Text Line on the back of each student identification card issued by the school district. Provides that if the school district does not issue student identification cards to its students or to all of its students, the school district must publish this information on its website. Effective July 1, 2020.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5 10-20.73 and 34-18.66 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.73 new)

7 Sec. 10-20.73. Student identification; suicide prevention
8 information. Each school district shall provide contact
9 information for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline and
10 for the Crisis Text Line on the back of each student
11 identification card issued by the school district. If the
12 school district does not issue student identification cards to
13 its students or to all of its students, the school district
14 must publish this information on its website.

15 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.66 new)

16 Sec. 34-18.66. Student identification; suicide prevention
17 information. The school district shall provide contact
18 information for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline and
19 for the Crisis Text Line on the back of each student
20 identification card issued by the school district. If the
21 school district does not issue student identification cards to
22 its students or to all of its students, the school district

1 must publish this information on its website.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
3 2020.
