# SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/4-8a new

Amends the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that no person shall knowingly use or accept cash assistance benefits provided under the Article for the purchase or sale of any firearm or firearms ammunition. Requires the Department of Human Services to adopt any rules necessary to implement the amendatory Act, including rules and practices to prevent recipients of cash assistance from accessing their cash assistance benefits at automated teller machines or point of sale terminals that are located in a store or other establishment in which the principal place of business is the sale of firearms or ammunitions.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 adding Section 4-8a as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/4-8a new)

Sec. 4-8a. Firearms purchase prohibited using TANF
<u>benefits.</u>
<u>(a) As used in this Section, "firearm" and "firearm</u>
<u>ammunition" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms in</u>
Section 31A-0.1 of the Criminal Code of 2012.

12 (b) No person shall knowingly use or accept cash assistance benefits provided under this Article for the purchase or sale 13 14 of any firearm or firearms ammunition. The Department shall adopt any rules necessary to implement this Section, including 15 16 rules and practices to prevent recipients of cash assistance from accessing their cash assistance benefits at automated 17 teller machines or point of sale terminals that are located in 18 19 a store or other establishment in which the principal place of 20 business is the sale of firearms or ammunitions.
