AN ACT concerning criminal law.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
amended by changing Section 106F-20 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 5/106F-20)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on July 1, 2020)

8 Sec. 106F-20. Task Force; meetings; duties.

9 (a) The Task Force on Children of Incarcerated Parents 10 shall meet at least 4 times beginning within 30 days after the 11 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General 12 Assembly. The first meeting shall be held no later than August 13 1, 2019.

14 (b) The Task Force shall review available research, best 15 practices, and effective interventions to formulate 16 recommendations.

(c) The Task Force shall produce a report detailing the Task Force's findings and recommendations and needed resources. The Task Force shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly and the Governor by March 1, 2020. <u>The Task Force shall continue to meet and issue</u> reports at its discretion.
