Introduced , by Rep. La Shawn K. Ford

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. III, Sec. 2

Proposes to amend the Suffrage and Elections Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that the General Assembly may by law provide for the right to vote of a person convicted of a felony, or otherwise under sentence in a correctional institution or jail, but in any event the right to vote shall be restored not later than upon completion of his or her sentence. Effective upon being declared adopted.

13	SECTION 2. VOTING <u>RIGHTS; FELONS</u> DISQUALIFICATIONS		
14	The General Assembly may by law provide for the right to		
15	vote of a person convicted of a felony, or otherwise under		
16	sentence in a correctional institution or jail, but in any		
17	event the right to vote shall be restored not later than upon		
18	completion of his or her sentence. A person convicted of a		
19	felony, or otherwise under sentence in a correctional		
20	institution or jail, shall lose the right to vote, which right		
21	shall be restored not later than upon completion of his		
22	sentence.
