HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives wish to congratulate Matthew Hoppesch on
4 achieving the rank of Eagle Scout with the Boy Scouts of
5 America, the highest and most-coveted honor in Scouting; and

7 as a Tiger Scout with Pack 399 based at St. Hubert Catholic
8 Church in Hoffman Estates; he crossed over to Troop 399 in
9 February 2011; he has attended National Youth Leadership
10 Training and held leadership positions within the troop as
11 chaplain's aide, scribe, and troop guide; and

12 WHEREAS, Matthew Hoppesch's Eagle Scout project, which is
13 required to be of significant value to the community, was to
14 rehabilitate a weather-worn garden shed on the property of St.
15 Matthew Catholic Church; this included obtaining donations
16 from numerous sources; he replaced rotting walls, trim boards,
17 and a soffit and then stained the entire shed in two colors;
