## HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The U.S. Congress passed into law the National 2 3 Childhood Vaccine Injury Act of 1986, which states that no 4 "vaccine manufacturer shall be liable in a civil action for 5 damages arising from a vaccine-related injury or death 6 associated with the administration of a vaccine after October 1, 1988, if the injury or death resulted from side effects that 7 8 were unavoidable even though the vaccine was properly prepared 9 and was accompanied by proper directions and warnings"; and

10 WHEREAS, In 2011, the United States Supreme Court ruled in 11 Bruesewitz v. Wyeth that the "National Childhood Vaccine Injury 12 Act pre-empts all design-defect claims against vaccine 13 manufacturers brought by plaintiffs who seek compensation for 14 injury or death caused by vaccine side effects"; and

15 WHEREAS, Our individual human rights should outweigh the 16 profits of pharmaceutical companies, and individuals should 17 have the ability to hold vaccine manufacturers liable for 18 design defects that result in adverse side effects from 19 vaccines; and

20 WHEREAS, The European Union has found a way to allow 21 evidence-based lawsuits to hold vaccine manufacturers liable 22 without destabilizing the European health care system; HR0762 -2- LRB101 20784 MST 70476 r therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 3 4 we urge the Congress of the United States to pass, and the 5 to sign, legislation removing 42 President U.S.C. 6 300aa-22(b)(1) from law and allowing design defect claims against vaccine manufacturers by individuals 7 who have 8 experienced adverse side effects caused by vaccines; and be it 9 further

10 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be 11 delivered to the President of the United States, the U.S. 12 Senate Majority Leader, the U.S. Speaker of the House of 13 Representatives, each member of the Illinois Congressional 14 Delegation, and the U.S. Secretary of Health and Human 15 Services.
