WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Sheila H. Schultz of Wheeling; and

WHEREAS, A Wheeling resident for more than 65 years, Sheila Schultz was elected as a village trustee in 1979 and became the first female village president in 1981; she served as village president for 16 years; she led Wheeling through a number of pivotal decisions that continue to define the village, including the purchase of the Palwaukee Airport; she loved Wheeling and its citizens and was the true definition of a public servant; she worked toward a more equitable environment for all residents, dedicating her focus to forming a human rights commission and a senior commission; during her tenure, Wheeling also created its first senior center, joined first-of-their-kind joint municipal organizations the Northwest Water Commission and the Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County, and constructed a new and modernized Metra train station to help residents more easily commute between the suburbs and Chicago; and
