Section 5. The Government Severance Pay Act is amended by
changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 415/10)

7 Sec. 10. Severance pay.

8 (a) A unit of government that enters into a contract or 9 employment agreement, or renewal or renegotiation of an 10 existing contract or employment agreement, that contains a 11 provision for severance pay with an officer, agent, employee, 12 or contractor must include the following provisions in the 13 contract:

(1) a requirement that severance pay provided may not
exceed an amount greater than 20 weeks of compensation; and
(2) a prohibition of provision of severance pay when
the officer, agent, employee, or contractor has been fired
for misconduct by the unit of government.

(b) Nothing in this Section creates an entitlement to severance pay in the absence of its contractual authorization or as otherwise authorized by law.

(c) Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
 this Act shall not apply to contracts or employment agreements
