1 AN ACT concerning government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Government Severance Pay Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 415/10)

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- 7 Sec. 10. Severance pay.
- 8 (a) A unit of government that enters into a contract or
 9 employment agreement, or renewal or renegotiation of an
 10 existing contract or employment agreement, that contains a
 11 provision for severance pay with an officer, agent, employee,
 12 or contractor must include the following provisions in the
 13 contract:
 - (1) a requirement that severance pay provided may not exceed an amount greater than 20 weeks of compensation; and
 - (2) a prohibition of provision of severance pay when the officer, agent, employee, or contractor has been fired for misconduct by the unit of government.
 - (b) Nothing in this Section creates an entitlement to severance pay in the absence of its contractual authorization or as otherwise authorized by law.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
 this Act shall not apply to contracts or employment agreements

- 1 for individuals employed by the department of intercollegiate
- 2 athletics of a college or university when the employee's
- 3 compensation is funded by non-State-appropriated funds, such
- 4 as revenues generated by athletic events or activities, gifts
- 5 or donations, or any combination thereof. Nothing in this
- 6 Section entitles an individual employed by the department of
- 7 <u>intercollegiate athletics of a college or university to receive</u>
- 8 severance pay when that individual has been dismissed for
- 9 misconduct.
