1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 654

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 654, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.  
4 2, as follows:

5 on page 2, line 16, by deleting "18.5,"; and

6 on page 31, line 19, by replacing "assistant professor  
7 ~~instructor~~" with "instructor"; and

8 by replacing line 19 on page 38 through line 7 on page 39 with  
9 the following:

10 "(e) Any person who has been duly licensed as a  
11 professional engineer by the Department and who chooses to  
12 deactivate or not renew his or her license may use the title  
13 "Professional Engineer, Retired". Those persons using the  
14 title "Professional Engineer, Retired" may request restoration  
15 to active status under the applicable provisions of Sections

1 17, 17.5, and 18 of this Act.

2 The use of the title "Professional Engineer, Retired" shall  
3 not constitute representation of current licensure. Any person  
4 without an active license shall not be permitted to practice  
5 engineering as defined in this Act.

6 Nothing in this Section shall be construed to require the  
7 Department to issue any certificate, credential, or other  
8 document indicating that a person has been granted the title,  
9 "Professional Engineer, Retired."; and

10 by deleting line 16 on page 40 through line 9 on page 41.
