1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Probate Act of 1975 is amended by changing

 Section 11a-1 as follows:
- 6 (755 ILCS 5/11a-1) (from Ch. 110 1/2, par. 11a-1)
- 7 Sec. 11a-1. Developmental disability defined.)
- 8 "Developmental disability" means a disability which is
- 9 attributable to: (a) an intellectual disability, cerebral
- 10 palsy, epilepsy or autism; or to (b) any other condition which
- 11 results in impairment similar to that that caused by an
- intellectual disability and which requires services similar to
- those required by persons with intellectual disabilities. Such
- 14 disability must originate before the age of 18 years, be
- 15 expected to continue indefinitely, and constitute a
- 16 substantial disability.
