Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Governor's Office of Management and Budget

 Act is amended by changing Section 6 as follows:

- Sec. 6. In performing its responsibility under Section 2.1, to assist the Governor in submitting a recommended budget, the

- (a) Distribute to all state agencies the proper blanks 10 11 necessary to the preparation of budget estimates, which blanks shall be in such form as shall be prescribed by the Director, 12 13 to procure, among other things, information as to the revenues 14 expenditures for the preceding fiscal year, appropriations made by the General Assembly for the preceding 15 fiscal year, the expenditures therefrom, obligations incurred 16 17 thereon, and the amounts unobligated and unexpended, estimate of the revenues and expenditures of the current fiscal 18 19 year, and an estimate of the revenues and amounts needed for 20 the respective departments and offices for the next succeeding
- 22 (b) Require from each state agency its estimate of receipts 23 and expenditures for the succeeding fiscal year, accompanied by

- 1 a statement in writing giving facts and explanation of reasons
- 2 for each item of expenditure requested.
- 3 (c) Make, at the discretion of the Director, further
- inquiries and investigations as to any item desired. 4
- 5 (d) Approve, disapprove or alter the estimates.
- (e) Publish a summary of each budget bill, which shall be 6
- written in comprehensive and clear language. 7
