3	inserting immediately below line 3 the following:
4	"Section 3. The Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act is
5	amended by changing Section 5-20 as follows:

8	delayed effective date)
9	(Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2021)
10	Sec. 5-20. Credit; time served; community service.
11	(a) Any credit for time served prior to sentencing that
12	reduces the amount a defendant is required to pay shall be
13	deducted first from the fine, if any, ordered by the court. Any
14	remainder of the credit shall be equally divided between the
15	assessments indicated in the ordered schedule and conditional
16	assessments.

- 1 Excluding any ordered conditional assessment, a (b) 2 defendant who has been ordered to pay an assessment may petition the court to convert all or part of the assessment 3 4 into court-approved public or community service. One hour of 5 public or community service shall be equivalent to \$4 of 6 assessment. The performance of this public or community service 7 shall be a condition of probation, conditional discharge, or supervision and shall be in addition to the performance of any 8 9 other period of public or community service ordered by the 10 court or required by law.

- on page 2, by inserting immediately below line 7 the following:
- "Section 95. No acceleration or delay. Where this Act makes changes in a statute that is represented in this Act by text that is not yet or no longer in effect (for example, a Section represented by multiple versions), the use of that text does not accelerate or delay the taking effect of (i) the changes made by this Act or (ii) provisions derived from any other Public Act.".
