5	on page 2, by replacing lines 5 throu	gh 20 with the following:
6	" <u>"Eligible postsecondary insti</u>	tution" means any public
7	institution in this State, inclu	uding the University of
8	Illinois, Southern Illinois Uni	iversity, Chicago State
9	University, Eastern Illinois Univ	versity, Governors State
10	University, Illinois State Universi	ty, Northeastern Illinois
11	University, Northern Illinois Univer	sity, and Western Illinois
12	University, any public community col	lege in this State, or any
13	other public university, college, or	r community college now or
14	hereafter established or authorized b	by the General Assembly.
15	"Eligible postsecondary program	m" means a program that
16	includes a curriculum of courses to	maintain a classroom role
17	in any child care or early childhood	education setting, leading

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1	to a Child Development certificate or associate degree (CDA),
2	an associate or bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education
3	(ECE), or a Professional Educator License (PEL)."; and
4	on page 3, by replacing lines 3 through 8 with the following:
5	"to all eligible child care workers seeking to enroll in an
6	eligible postsecondary program at an eligible postsecondary
7	institution. All of the following terms and conditions"; and
8	on page 3, by replacing lines 12 through 15 with the following:
9	"certificate, (ii) be admitted to and enrolled in an eligible
10	postsecondary program at an eligible postsecondary
11	institution, and (iii) have an individually adjusted gross
12	income equal to or less than \$65,000."; and
13	by replacing line 25 on page 3 through line 6 on page 4 with the
14	following:
15	"cost of tuition and mandatory fees at an eligible
16	postsecondary institution or eligible postsecondary program
17	attended, less all other student aid. Student aid shall be
18	credited first to"; and
19	on page 4, by replacing lines 12 through 15 with the following:
20	"required books and supplies, lab fees, and activity fees. Each
21	eligible postsecondary institution or eligible postsecondary
22	program must annually report to the Commission its"; and

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1	on page 4, by replacing lines 18 and 19 with the following:
2	"renewals until (i) he or she has earned a bachelor's degree in
3	ECE, (ii) he or she obtains a Professional Educator License, or
4	(iii) 8 years have passed from the date of the student's
5	initial receipt of a grant under this program."; and
6	on page 4, by replacing lines 23 through 25 with the following:
7	"setting for the same period of time in which he or she
8	received funding under the program. If the student fails to
9	fulfill this requirement, the student must repay the total
10	grant amount awarded"; and
11	on page 5, immediately below line 7, by inserting the
12	following:
13	"The Commission must adopt rules, in consultation with the
14	Early Childhood Workforce Free College Advisory Committee
15	created under subsection (e), on the distribution of grants
16	under this subsection.".
