Amend Senate Bill 2135, AS AMENDED, 2 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 3 4 5, on page 20, line 17, by replacing "30-day" with "120-day"; 5 and on page 37, by replacing line 25 with the following: 6 7 "the State at all times. Beginning on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly through June 8 9 30, 2022, any such zoological park must be open to the public 10 without charge: (i) a total number of days, to be scheduled at any time during the calendar year, equivalent to at least one 11 day for each 14 days the zoological park is open during the 12 calendar year; and (ii) to the children in actual attendance 13 upon any of the schools in the State at all times.
