SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 105/5 new

Amends the Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act. Provides that a unit of local government may not use public funds to pay a lobbyist or lobbying entity. Limits home rule powers.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act is amended by adding Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (50 ILCS 105/5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5. Use of public funds for lobbyists.</u>
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "lobbyist" and "lobbying
 9 entity" have the meanings given to those terms in Section 2 of
 10 the Lobbyist Registration Act.
- 11 (b) A unit of local government may not use public funds to
- pay a lobbyist or lobbying entity.
- 13 (c) A home rule unit may not expend public funds in a
- 14 <u>manner inconsistent with this Section. This Section is a</u>
- 15 <u>limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of</u>
- 16 the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home
- 17 <u>rule units of powers and functions exercised by the State.</u>
