SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Cigarette Filter Plastic Ban Act. Provides that, beginning 2 years after the effective date of the Act, a cigarette shall not utilize a single-use filter containing cellulose acetate, another plastic material, or any non-biodegradable material.

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Cigarette Filter Plastic Ban Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. In this Act:
- 7 "Non-biodegradable material" means any substance that,
- 8 when littered or discarded, is not readily changed to a
- 9 harmless natural state by the action of bacteria.
- "Single-use" means any product reasonably expected to be
- 11 discarded by consumers after a single use.
- 12 Section 10. Prohibition on use of plastic. Beginning 2
- 13 years after the effective date of this Act, a cigarette shall
- 14 not utilize a single-use filter containing cellulose acetate,
- another plastic material, or any non-biodegradable material in
- 16 this State.
