SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

415 ILCS 5/11.2 new

Amends the Environmental Protection Act. Provides that a pesticide applicator shall notify a beekeeper if the pesticide is applied within 3 miles of the beekeeper's colony registered with the Department of Agriculture under the Bees and Apiaries Act. Effective January 1, 2021.

- 4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
- 5 adding Section 11.2 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 5/11.2 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 11.2. Pesticide applicators; beekeepers. A pesticide</u>
- 8 applicator shall notify a beekeeper, as that term is defined
- 9 under Section 1a of the Bees and Apiaries Act, if the pesticide
- is applied within 3 miles of the beekeeper's colony registered
- with the Department of Agriculture under the Bees and Apiaries
- 12 Act.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
- 14 1, 2021.
