## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3105/4.02

from Ch. 127, par. 774.02

Amends the Capital Development Board Act. Provides that the Capital Development Board shall develop and periodically revise a Statewide master plan for non-road infrastructure. Provides that the Capital Development Board shall coordinate its planning activities with those of other State agencies and authorities and shall supervise and review any infrastructure planning performed by other executive branch agencies under the direction of the Governor. Provides that the Capital Development Board shall publish and deliver the Statewide master plan for non-road infrastructure to the Governor and General Assembly by December 31, 2020 and by December 31 every 5 years thereafter. Effective immediately.

building or otherwise providing the facilities described in

10 The Board shall develop and maintain a continuing, comprehensive, and integrated planning process that shall 11 12 develop and periodically revise a Statewide master plan for non-road infrastructure to guide program development. The 13 14 Board shall coordinate its planning activities with those of other State agencies and authorities and shall supervise and 15 review any infrastructure planning performed by other 16 17 executive branch agencies under the direction of the Governor. The Board shall cooperate and participate with federal, 18 regional, State, and local agencies and with interested private 19 20 individuals and organizations in the coordination of plans and 21 policies for development of the State's non-road 22 infrastructure. To meet the provisions of this Section, the Board shall publish and deliver to the Governor and General 23
