Amend Senate Bill 3224 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by 4 adding Section 232 as follows: 5 6 (35 ILCS 5/232 new) 7 Sec. 232. Volunteer firefighters and volunteer EMS 8 providers. (a) For taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 9 10 2021, each individual who serves as a volunteer firefighter, a volunteer EMS provider, or a volunteer emergency worker during 11 the taxable year is entitled to a credit against the taxes 12 13 imposed by subsections (a) and (b) of Section 201 in an amount equal to \$500. Taxpayers shall reapply for the credit on an 14 15 annual basis.

(b) In no event shall a credit under this Section reduce a

- organization of which the individual is a member that (i) the 18

- 20 provider organization for not fewer than 6 months of the
- 21 calendar year for which the tax credit is claimed and (ii) the
- 22 individual has met all participation and training requirements
- of the fire department or the EMS provider organization for 23
